Redeemer lives), BWV 160, is a church cantata formerly attributed to Johann Sebastian Bach. It was composed around 1725 by Georg Philipp Telemann for Easter Sunday. A manuscript copy from the 1800s identified Bach as the composer of the work, and on this basis it was given a BWV number in an 1886 catalogue.
